Opening:

Administrative/Financial Report:

Our Bank of America account is currently holding about \$28,294.71. The Pay Pal account holds about \$2,069.52. Our total holdings are \$30,364.23. Our core amount subtracting out the pending promotions to be sent out is approximately \$27,542.23.

One U.S. dollar continues to grow stronger against the yen. It is currently at about 122 Japanese yen to the U.S. dollar. At the last meeting, the yen was at about 120 yen to the

dollar. Following the last meeting, fees were reduced for godan and rokudan. The fees for shodan to yondan remain the same.

The office continues to perform upgrades to the website. Our database system is being upgraded to File Maker 14. The estimated cost for software will be approximately \$900.00.

Please make sure you have all downloaded and printed the new Guidelines, Rev. March 2015. The Quick Reference for processing ranks has also been edited to show the new prices for godan and rokudan.

All member dojos are paid for the year. This is the first year we have everyone paid up by the February meeting.

Reminder that membership fees must be received by January 31st. After that date, the member is charged a \$25.00 late fee. Delinquent members will be sent one notice to submit payment of \$100.00 by February 25th, after which they will be terminated and must seek admittance through their Division Head.
