Administrative/Financial Report:

Our Bank of America account is currently holding about \$35,214.36. The Pay Pal account holds about \$674.57. Our total holdings are \$35,888.93. Our core amount subtracting out the pending March promotions to be sent out is approximately \$31,608.93.

One U.S. dollar is about 113 Japanese yen. The yen is gaining strength. We will maintain our current prices for membership and ranks.

The office continues to perform upgrades to the website and databases. We hope to have remodeled databases within the next six months.

As of today, 7 member dojos are outstanding in their membership fees. These members are facing a termination notice if payment is not rendered. Terminated members will have to pay a \$75.00 registration fee, the \$75.00 annual fee and a \$25.00 late fee. \$175.00 to be reinstated.
